**ORDER DENYING
PROTECTION ORDER**

Upon review of the petition and affidavit under the Protection From Domestic Abuse Act, the Court finds that the petition should be dismissed without prejudice. The Court finds that the existing restraining order entered in Case No. 4874 provides essentially the same relief as that sought in the current petition, that violation of the existing restraining order would constitute a crime under § 42-357, and that it is not a proper and efficient use of judicial resources to allow multiple and overlapping orders on the same subject. Any extensions or modifications of the existing restraining order shall be sought in Case No. 4874 rather than by filing of a separate protection order application. Of course, the situation could change if Case No. 4874 was to be dismissed.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. The petition is denied without prejudice.
2. The costs of filing are waived and ordered paid by this county. Complete record is not required.
