ORDER: The motion is denied without prejudice because:

1. The *affidavit* fails to address the status of the records of the State Disbursement Unit since December 21, 2001. See *Hinds Cty. Dep't of Human Servs. obo Magee v. Wheeler*, NEDC8 2002-039 (Neb. 8th Dist. Ct. 2002).

2. The affidavit relies solely upon the "records of the Clerk of this Court," and the clerk of the district court is not responsible for maintaining support payment records regarding occurrences from and after the operative date of the State Disbursement Unit. The purported attachment to the affidavit is obviously *not* "records of the Clerk of this Court," and is not otherwise properly identified and incorporated in the affidavit.
