ORDER

SUBJECT OF ORDER: Cancellation of regularly-scheduled motion days until further order.

ORDER: The court finds, determines, and orders:

1. The undersigned district judge, being the regular judge automatically assigned to all matters in the Northern Division of the Eighth Judicial District, has been appointed to the Nebraska Court of Appeals, and expects to assume such office on or about January 2, 2004. Upon assuming office as a judge of the court of appeals, the office of district court judge will become vacant.

2. The court has contemporaneously entered specific orders in most cases continuing scheduled pretrial conferences, progression conferences, sentencings, and other matters until further order of the successor district judge or the presiding judge. However, there may be other matters scheduled by one or more parties on a motion day calendar that have not been addressed by specific order.

3. All motion days scheduled in this county on or after January 2, 2004, are canceled until further order. All matters scheduled for a motion day which would have occurred on or after January 2, 2004, are continued until further order by the successor

district judge or the presiding judge, or until properly renoticed for hearing in accordance with procedures adopted by the successor district judge or the presiding judge.

4. The court clerk shall not allow any further matters to be scheduled or noticed for any motion day on or after January 2, 2004, except by specific approval of the successor district judge or the presiding judge, and shall notify any party or attorney attempting to schedule any such hearing of this order.

5. As to any pending matter scheduled to be heard on or after January 2, 2004, for which no specific order has been provided, the clerk shall file a copy of this order in the case file and mail a copy to all counsel of record and any pro se parties.

6. The court clerk shall distribute a copy of this order to all attorneys having their principal offices in such county and to the county court.
