G I. As to any **child support or spousal support** ordered above:
(1) The income of the party ordered to pay such support shall be subject to **income withholding**, which shall be implemented pursuant to the Income Withholding for Child Support Act.
(2) In the event that such party **fails to pay** any child, medical, or spousal support payments, as such failure is certified each month by the State Disbursement Unit in cases where court-ordered support is delinquent in an amount equal to the support due and payable for a one-month period of time, such party may be required to appear before this Court on a date to be determined by the Court and show cause why such payment was not made. In the event such party fails to pay and appear as so ordered, a warrant shall be issued for such party's arrest.

G J. **Each party** shall be required to **furnish the court clerk**, in writing, with such party's address (including specific street address or other physical location, in addition to mailing address), telephone number, and social security number, the name and address of such party's employer, whether or not such person has access to employer-related health insurance coverage and, if so, the health insurance policy information, and any other **information** that the Court shall deem relevant until any judgment for alimony, child support, property settlement, attorneys fees, and/or costs, herein made are paid in full. Each party shall also be required to advise the clerk of any changes in such information between the time of entry of this order and payment of the judgment in full, within ten (10) days after the effective date of such change. Failure to comply with the provisions of this section shall be punishable by contempt.
